The Nursing standards of practice were developed by the American Nurses Association as a guideline to ensure expected nursing performances (AANP, 2020). In the legal point of view, this refers to the rules of what nurses are required to adhere to practice competency in the work. This means that the nurse needs to work under a lot of caution, attentiveness and prudence; if one fails to meet these standards then they are liable for damages caused by the level of negligence (AANP, 2020). The medical meaning of standards of nursing practice however looks at the level to which the nurse maintains the highest levels of care for patients and following the established procedures (AANP, 2020).
